History

The Manoir and the Clos de la Perrière is in the Joliet family since 1853. Made of a single parcel of 5 hectares of vineyards and a magnificent building from the XII century, this domaine is a must see. The wine is still made in this old Manoir.

The wines

Philippe et Bénigne Joliet produce only one wine on the Clos de la Perrière, most of it is red and a little white is also done. Both have the appellation Fixin Ier Cru Clos de la Perrière. They take car of the wines during 3 years before it is ready; this is due to the freshness of the cellar which slows down the evolution of the wine.

This single parcel is located on the top of the hill of Fixin, bringing some powerful aromas of small ripened fruits, roasted coffee, leather. This wine has a huge potential of aging.
