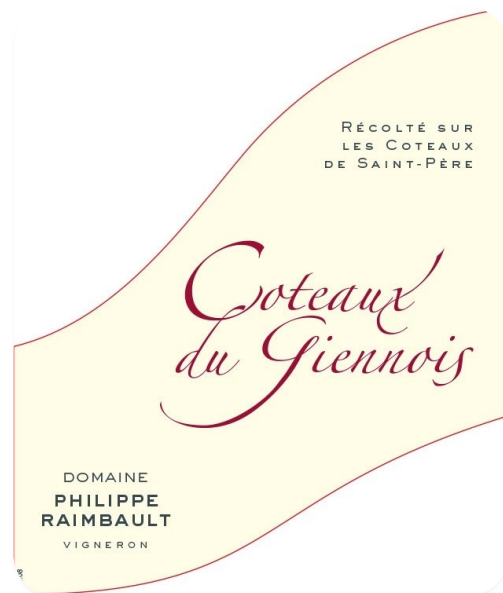

The desire to preserve our terroir for future generations starts with our respect of nature it's biodiversity, enabling us to produce good authentic wines.

Vines & Wines

Our Sancerre wines are from our vineyards growing on the steep slopes surrounding the village of Sury-en-vaux. The Pouilly Fumé wines come from the limestone-clay soils of the appellation, in the commune of Saint-Martin-Sur-Nohain. As for the Coteaux du Giennois, they are harvested on the slopes of Saint-Père overlooking the Loire and the town of Cosne-sur-Loire.

Pouilly Fumé, Sancerre Blanc and Coteaux du Giennois Blanc are all

produced from 100% Sauvignon blanc grapes.

Sancerre Red and Rosé are produced from 100% Pinot noir, while the red Coteaux du Giennois is composed of 80% Pinot noir and 20% Gamay.
