The wines
Their vineyard, swept by the Mistral wind, is classified in Côtes du Rhône and Côtes du Rhône Villages.

A sandy soil for the whites. Viognier, Grenache blanc, Marsanne and Roussane compose the wines.

A mix of Limestone and clay for the reds, made of Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah, Marselan.
